


Each day the Los Angeles Fire Department is dispatched to over 1,000 incidents across a City that is 469 square miles.

Paramedics and Firefighters perform their job of saving lives, with LESS AND LESS RESOURCES each year. Response times have **INCREASED**, while the number of firefighters and the equipment they rely on to save lives has **DECREASED**.

Los Angeles Fire Department by the Numbers:

- There are 125 FEWER PARAMEDICS and FIREFIGHTERS on duty each day than there were just four years ago.
- The Fire Department transports over **550 PATIENTS TO** THE HOSPITAL EACH DAY.
- The City has **NOT HIRED** a Paramedic or Firefighter in **OVER THREE YEARS.**
- In a City of nearly 3.8 million people, there is only ONE FIREFIGHTER FOR EVERY 4,000 PEOPLE.

PROPOSITION A WILL PROTECT LOS ANGELES and will help prevent the reduction in size of our Fire Department, prevent increased response times, stop the closure of neighborhood fire resources on a rotating basis, and ENSURE THAT THE LAPD DOES NOT LAY OFF 500 POLICE OFFICERS.
