

Vote-by-mail and Vote Yes on Measures GG + HH + II



Measures GG + HH generate revenue and directs the City Council to fund much needed improvements to our streets, sidewalks, library and critical public safety equipment. HH advises the City that the new revenue not be spent on salaries or other employee benefits.



Measures GG + HH will generate approximately \$4,000,000 per year from a ³/₄ cent sales tax increase. Sales of unprepared food, prescription medications and certain medical supplies are exempt and Measures GG + HH cannot change that.



Measure II prepares the City and its residents for growth, innovative building and open space. Measure II supports the community's desire to protect our diverse residential neighborhoods and parks while sustaining business districts that attract people from throughout the region.
